**Squires Report:** Tim Bowie is the interim Chief Councilor for now, Justin Stone will continue to assist him.

**Right to Life Director:** Dick Patterson stated volunteers are needed on April 1<sup>st</sup> to prayer at the Founders Clinic on Board St. as part of the 40 Days for Life initiative.

**Scholarship:** Great job to Gene Elbert on this program as 4 applications were received.

**Fish Fries:** Still on for now.

**Blue Coat Dinner:** Dick Petersen is starting to work on it, scheduled for April 25<sup>th</sup>, will send out invitations in early March.

**Teachers Appreciation Dinner:** GK Frank Hare asked for volunteers to serve as bartenders for the Teachers Appreciation Dinner on Sat. evening, April 4<sup>th</sup> in Herman Hall.

**Car Show:** Jesus Garcia is planning to hold a Car Show on Sunday, August 16<sup>th</sup> from 12 to 4 pm during the Seton Festival.

**Public Relations:** Francis Wilamosky, let him know of any topics for the bulletin.

**Unfinished Business:**

GK Frank Hare indicated that we have 2,000 Easter "Christ is Risen" magnets left, and St. John XXIII Knights are interested so he will contact their Grand Knight to see how many they want and the reminder will be handed out at the Fish Fries.

Francis Wilamosky stated that 180 Knights have paid their 2020 dues, but there are still 40 Knights that have not yet paid.
